## Principal's Report

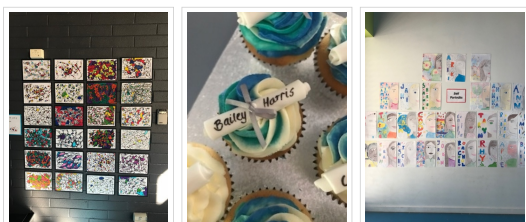


Dear Parents/Carers and Families,
