one of the key areas of STEAM learning – science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics!

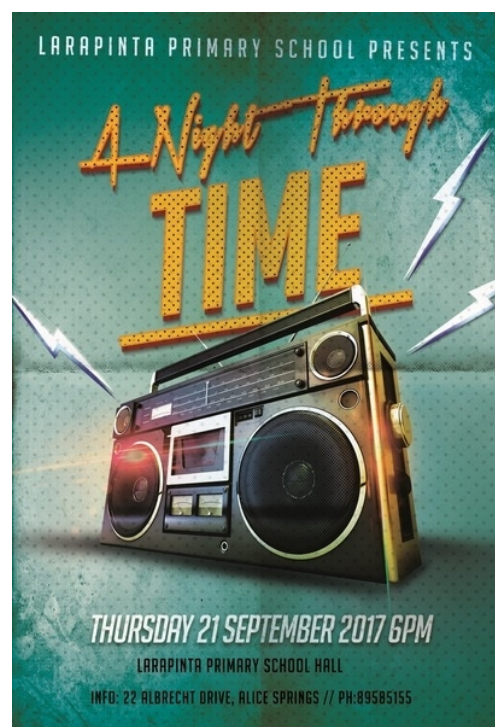
1. **Science** in the **science room** with Mr K

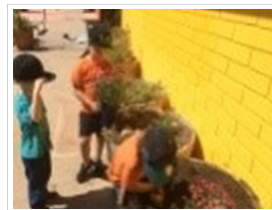
## Gardening at Preschool
