ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Hi everyone,

Last Wednesday night, less than a week after our school concert, we had another BIG performance – Alice Can Dance at Araluen. It was a HUGE day and night for our students and staff, with the last child collected at 9:15pm. This was an excellent opportunity for our children to shine on the big stage. They represented themselves, their families, and their school proudly, and were so well behaved throughout the evening. Thanks to our staff and the team at GUTS Dance Central Australia.

I have a couple of things to bring to your attention in this newsletter.

Teachers have been talking to students about sharing food at school. This is not something we do at Larapinta. Families make decisions about what they purchase for their children,

and we need all students to eat what they bring in their own lunch boxes, rather than swap with someone else. Please do not send unhealthy, sugar-laden snacks to school, and definitely no lollies or fizzy drinks.

School starts at 8:30am and finishes at 2:50pm. Teachers are on duty from 8:10am and students who arrive before this time are required to sit beside the front office. At the end of each day, we supervise until 3:10pm. After this time, teachers have meetings and other responsibilities. Please ensure your children are collected before 3:10pm.

A reminder that school uniform is compulsory in the Northern Territory. Our uniform is the Larapinta t-shirt and navy shorts/skorts. We have an ever-decreasing stash of second-hand uniforms in the office for children to borrow if they come to school out of uniform. If you have any uniforms your children have outgrown, we would appreciate donations!

We have a 'no hat, no play' policy. Students must have a bucket hat or stay in the library/on blue benches in the shade. Please label all articles of clothing clearly with your child's name so they can be returned if (or when!) they become lost.

Finally, I have sent a letter home to some families

highlighting concerns around the amount of time young children are spending on devices watching YouTube. While they start on something seemingly innocent, the algorithms embedded in the app quickly take them to clips that contain inappropriate or explicit content. Students then come to school and talk about or act out what they are seeing on the screens. Please monitor what your children are watching and try to limit screen time and replace it with something active or stimulating for their young brains.

Friday 22nd September is Footy Colours Day at Larapinta. This is a day to raise money for kids with cancer, so we would like all students to bring a gold coin donation. We understand that not everyone has a footy outfit, so we are encouraging students to wear any team colours e.g. netball, soccer, tennis, BMX...The student leaders will take on the staff in a game of netball at 10:30am. Join us if you are able!

We have one more day before the break, and I know lots of people are looking forward to a chance to recharge and get ready for the final term of the year. If you are travelling somewhere, please do so safely. If you are staying in town, try to stay cool and check out our FB page for activities that are happening in town. The CFC took families to Angkerle Atwatye (Standley Chasm) for a Community planning trip. Whilst there we engaged in a Special cultural experience tour. The tour included a guided walk where we tasted bush coconut, saw different bush plants,

it also included an information session where we learnt about Aboriginal culture and history and lastly an art activity where we got to paint animals and boomerang stencils.





The aim of this Community planning trip was to spark conversation with community members on how we can include Aboriginal culture and 2 way learning in the projects that are happening in Larapinta. (Community Footpath, Bus Shelters)
